Program cost: \$250. Scholarships available.

HOW TO APPLY

The goal of the Jewish Latino Teen Coalition is to get youth involved in cultural understanding, leadership training, social action and advocacy. Get one letter of recommendation from a teacher or mentor. Answer the following questions (2 pages maximum for all questions):

- Why are you interested in being a participant in the Coalition program and trip to Washington DC?
- What can you contribute to the Coalition?
- Briefly describe an experience where you learned more about your own or someone else's culture

Attend an interview in November (finalists will be contacted for interviews). The program will begin with a mandatory meeting for all selected participants. The meeting will be held on a Sunday in December, exact date and location TBD.
