AASSD Regional Teams & Support Services:

Our department staff are divided into regional/school teams to serve African American students at all 80+ schools. Please see the attached document to locate your assigned staff member. AASSD staff presence varies throughout the month to accommodate all sites. In addition, the attached AASSD Support infographic outlines some of what you can expect from regional/school teams.

RTI Services:

RTI services provided by AASSD certified teachers target literacy at the elementary level. We are excited to expand RTI services to 13 sites. You can expect more sites to be added as two additional RTI Specialists are in the Human Resources que.

Royal Readers:

Based on end of the year DIBELS data, AASSD is targeting 500 African American students currently in grades 1st-3rd to participate in the Royal Readers Early Literacy Initiative. Through this initiative, targeted *returning* students are provided a loaner iPad, hotspots (if needed), and headphones to complete interventions at home. Orientations were held with parents/guardians during the summer. Please note, technology is distributed and collected by AASSD.
