This is similar to the Downtown BID The services for this BID will be security and sanitation. The Fourth Avenue Merchants Association and Historic Fourth Avenue Coalition know sanitation and security are issues in the area. The city has agreed to handle the BID. The area does include Tucson High. The proposed boundaries are University to Maclovio Barraza Parkway and Stone to Euclid. Only businesses will be taxed. This would cost approximately \$100 a month.
